RE: Affidavit regarding Romanze Mosby

I, Michael Lee Richardson was locked up in S.C.C.C., in Licking Missouri from the year of 2002 until 2005. While I was there I ran into a guy that I knew by the name of Romanze Mosby from Sikeston Missouri. I've known the Mosby family for awhile. Anyway it was a rumor going around that he may know something about David Robinsons Case. I had received a letter from Mr. Robinson saying that he had talked to his lawyers and they were coming to S.C.C.C. to speak with Mr. Mosby. Mr. Mosby had stated that someone was coming to speak with him. Soon after the visit that Mr. Mosby had he stated that they tried to get him to confess to a murder that Mr. Robinson was charged and locked up for. He told me that he didnt say anything and they were mad. A week or two later I got a letter from Mr. Robinson saying that Mr. Mosby had confessed to everything. I remember showing that letter to other offenders as well. Soon after that Mr. Mosby started to act different around certain people, meaning

people from the Bootheel Area that he may have known. I also seen the change in Mr. Mosby. He started to stay in his cell alot and not coming outside. Once I had the chance to see Mr. Mosby I asked him was he cool, or did he have any problems. At first he said he was alright. Later he started to ask me alot of questions about Manslaughter and how did I get my Manslaughter. I told him that each case is different and that just because I got Manslaughter doesn't mean that the next person can get it as well. I then asked him why was he asking me about Manslaughter. He then said that he wanted to speak to me about something, but it would be on another day. I agreed to speak with him. He, Mr. Mosby said that he shot the woman that Mr. Robinson was locked up for, but he done it in self-defense because he thought that the woman was going to rob him, but he was to scared to tell anyone. He then said that he told the people who came to visit him the same thing, and while he was telling me that he started to cry. I told him to keep that information to himself and that it would be o.k. I also told him that he done the right thing because Mr. Robinson was charged with something that he didn't do. I told him that its not the end of the road.
