NOTICE OF ELECTION

Notice is hereby given that the General Municipal Election will be held in the County of Cape Girardeau on Tuesday, April 7, 2015 as certified to this office by the participating entities of Cape Girardeau County. The ballot for the Election shall be in substantially the following form.

QUESTION

Shall the County of Cape Girardeau, Missouri impose a local use tax at the same rate as the total local sales tax rate, currently one percent (1%), provided that if the local sales tax rate is reduced or raised by voter approval, the local use tax rate shall also be reduced or raised by the same action? A use tax return shall not be required to be filed by persons whose purchases from out-of-state vendors do not in total exceed two thousand dollars in any calendar year.

The proposal is an attempt to eliminate the current sales tax advantage that Non-Missouri vendors have over Missouri vendors.

The purpose of the tax is to provide funding for capital improvements to include a new courthouse facility.

Shall the Board of Education of the Cape Girardeau School District No. 63 borrow money in the amount of Twenty Million Dollars (\$20,000,000) for the purpose of acquiring, constructing, renovating, expanding, improving, furnishing and equipping school sites, buildings and related facilities for school purposes, including renovations to Central Junior High School, construction of an addition to the Career and Technology Center and HVAC upgrades throughout the District, and issue general obligation bonds for the payment thereof? If this proposition is approved, the adjusted debt service levy of the school district is estimated to remain unchanged at \$0.68 per one hundred dollars assessed valuation of real and personal property.

If this proposition is approved, the adjusted operating levy of the District is estimated to increase from \$3.2581 currently, to the ceiling of \$3.6000 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation in school year 2015-2016 and thereafter.

Shall the Board of Education of the Advance R-IV School District, Missouri, borrow money in the amount of One Million Eight Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$1,850,000) for the purpose of providing funds to combine with resources from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) for the site development, construction, equipping and furnishing of a storm shelter and classroom addition; to complete roof repairs and replacement; to the extent funds are available, to complete other repairs and renovations to the existing school buildings; and issue bonds for the payment thereof resulting in an estimated increase to the debt service property tax levy of \$0.17 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation? If this proposition is approved, the adjusted debt service levy of the School District is estimated to increase from \$0.3774 to \$0.5474 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation of real and personal property.
